Spring Feeding (Early Spring)

Green up with our early spring application. A careful lawn examination and an application of a slow release fertilizer and crabgrass pre-emergent provides the perfect balance to encourage growth, prevent crabgrass before it germinates to promote a healthy green lawn.

This is a great time to have your soil sampled so we can identify any hidden issues.

Broadleaf Weed Control (Late Spring)

Liquid weed killer is blanket applied to your entire lawn to keep the area weed-free.



Early Summer Fertilization (Early Summer)

A slow-release fertilizer including micro-nutrients is applied to promote new growth in preparation for the summer months. Also includes a weed spot treatment if necessary.



Mid-Summer Fertilization (Mid-Summer)

A new round of slow-release fertilizer is applied to maintain lawn health. Also includes a weed spot treatment if necessary.



Broadleaf Weed Control (Early Fall)

A final liquid weed killer is blanket applied to your entire lawn to kill any weeds that have germinated before winter weather sets in.



Fall Fertilization (Fall)

A well-balanced fertilizer is applied to keep your lawn green and lush during cooler months.



If you did not utilize our soil sampling and analysis during the spring, this is a great time to get them done. This gives us a great opportunity to fine tune your final fertilizer application and begin to make any soil health adjustment that may be needed.

Late-Fall Fertilization (Late Fall)

Fertilizers high in potassium are applied to strengthen your grass and keep it healthy during the cold winter months.
